PATH Resource Center

The PATH Resource Center encompasses the PATH Volunteer Hub, PATH Community Link, and the Center for Nonprofit Excellence. The Resource Center also operates community meeting rooms (available free-of-charge to nonprofits) and provides office space for the Fauquier Chamber of Commerce, Leadership Fauquier, and the Humankind Ways to Work program, which allows individuals with challenging credit histories to obtain financing for reliable transportation.



PATH Volunteer Hub

The PATH Volunteer Hub is home to **letsvolunteer.org**, an online platform that connects local nonprofits with community members looking to volunteer their time. Today, more than **8,241** volunteers are registered on the platform. In addition, the PATH Volunteer Hub spearheads a year-round volunteer initiative called **Let's Volunteer!** and our annual **Season of Giving** around the holidays.

PATH Community Link

PATH Community Link is a free, confidential service connecting residents of Fauquier, Rappahannock, Culpeper, Madison, and Orange counties with community resources. Our staff helps individuals find resources for a variety of needs including housing assistance, transportation, healthcare, food relief, childcare, and more.

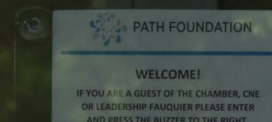

WAYS TO WORK

HumanKind's Ways to Work program offers fair-interest car loans for working people who can afford a monthly payment but may not have perfect credit. Program Manager John Rogers is here locally to talk it through, answer questions, and help neighbors figure out whether Ways to Work could be a good fit for their situation. Living in a semi-rural to rural community, transportation options are limited. John wants to help, not judge: "If you're wondering whether this could help you, it's worth reaching out. You don't need to have everything figured out before you start. There's no wrong way to begin; we'll meet you where you are."

Give Local Piedmont is the Northern Piedmont Community Foundation's (NPCF) annual day of giving where community members are encouraged to give back to local nonprofits. The 24-hour giving event connects our communities, increases awareness of our nonprofits, and incentivizes the "give where you live" mindset. PATH partners with NPCF by providing a \$100,000 bonus pool, ensuring that every participating nonprofit receives a portion of these additional funds based on the total amount they raise. **On May 12, 2026, almost 3,000 community members gave nearly \$1.1M to 227 organizations! Since the program began, nonprofits have received over \$12M.**



At PlayDate, children learn best through play. The nonprofit children's museum welcomes kids from Culpeper and surrounding counties to reach their full potential and make a difference in the world, developing critical thinking skills through engaging, hands-on play.

PlayDate Executive Director Maggie Kardos had the idea to create PlayDate when she and other parents realized they were frequenting the same spots, sparking the question of why there wasn't a local indoor play space for young kids.

CELEBRATING 10 YEARS OF PATH INTERNS: BRYCE HARTY

Between E-Squared presentations at the Culpeper Technical Education Center, we had the opportunity to reconnect with Career Partners Board Member and former PATH intern Bryce Harty. Bryce (28) was raised in Culpeper County and attended the University of Virginia's College at Wise when he discovered the PATH Foundation Summer Internship. As PATH celebrates 10 years of its intern program, Bryce reflects on his experience as a member of the 2018 intern class. ***"I was assigned to Culpeper Parks and Recreation, which was a dream because I was involved in basketball camp. It was a surreal moment when I was assigned to work with a volunteer who had been my elementary P.E. teacher, over ten years later. It was a full circle moment."*** Since that summer, Bryce has continued to call the region home and stays involved with several civic organizations. ***"I'm a board member at Career Partners; they have a big impact on preparing students for the workforce through programs like E-Squared."***

I've coached, judged, and been on the management team. I've seen every facet and know how much time and energy it takes." Bryce is also involved with Third Thursdays through Culpeper Renaissance, a monthly downtown event that brings the community together with live music, food, and activities for kids.

"I joined in 2021 and it was really impactful coming out of COVID and people could connect with each other again. It reminded me that I'm a product of everything people have done for me in my life." Looking back on his experiences at PATH, Bryce sees it as an entry point into lasting public participation.

"PATH is about community-driven involvement. It's not pigeonholing you into working for a nonprofit, but being civically engaged."

As PATH marks a decade of investing in young people across the region, Bryce encourages others to take that first step.

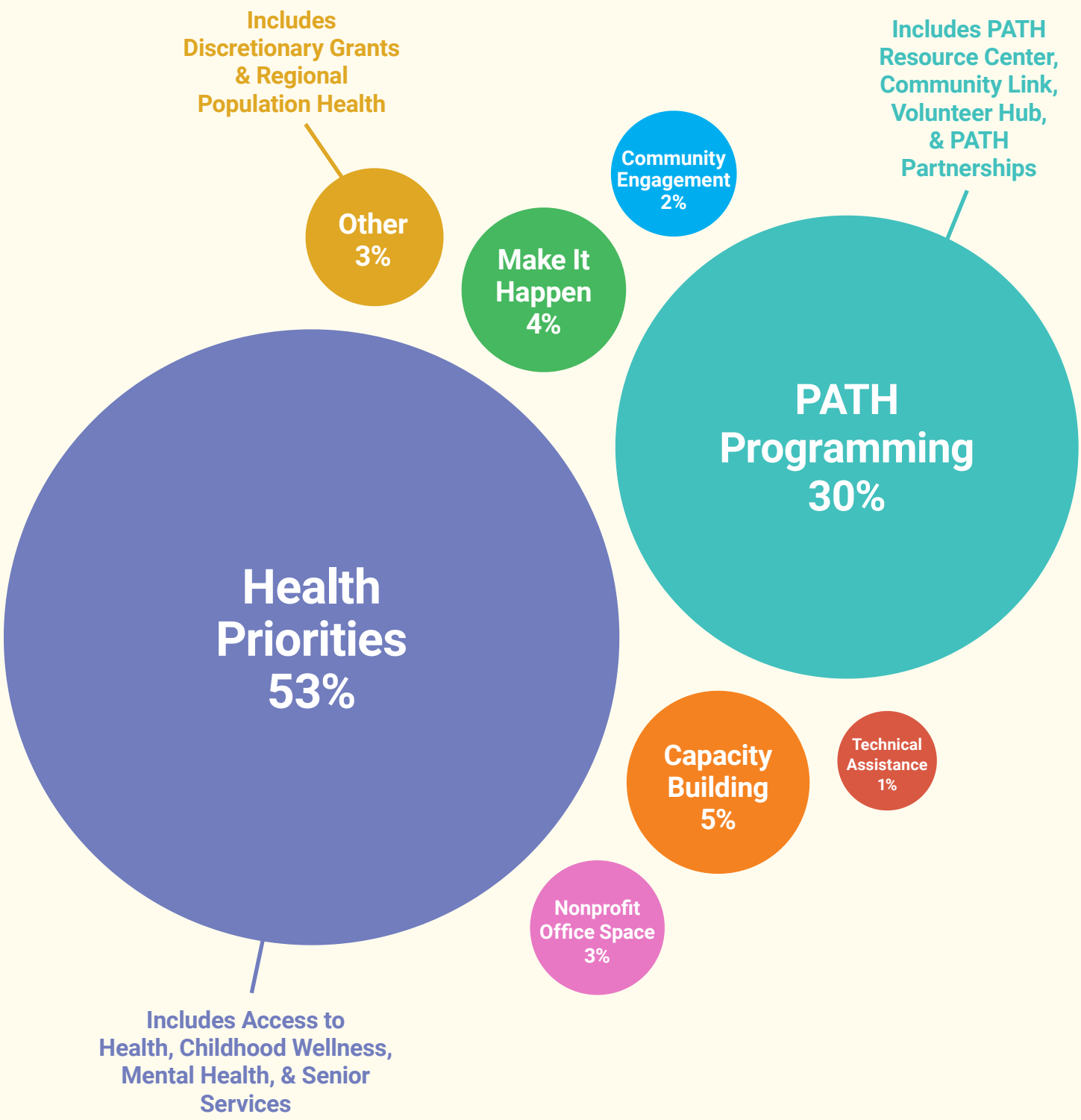
